Studies show children with fathers who are engaged in their lives have more positive life experiences. They develop healthy relationships and are less likely to have emotional or physical problems, perform better academically and subsequently in their jobs and careers. The Fatherhood Initiative Program strives to re-engage fathers with their children and support the whole family in their efforts to overcome struggles and improve their lives.

Services Provided:

- Individualized services and case management.
- Father-child relationship support and education.
- Career and Employment Services.
- Financial literacy and planning.
- Nurturing Fathers Class.
- RentWise Class.
- Children in Between co-parenting class.
- Referrals to other services and support.
- Father-led SMART goals.
- Trauma-Informed approach.

The program also works with fathers who are incarcerated. Through partnerships with organizations such as Beyond Prison, the Fatherhood team provides a safe and supportive network for men, before and after release. This strategic effort reduces recidivism and strengthens the parent/child relationship.

Referrals:

- Refers clients to services that support the client's economic stability, education, parenting, and/or well-being.
- Case managers can refer client to receive legal services.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Fathers living in Nebraska.
- US citizen or documented individual.
- Couples maybe accepted on a case by case situation.
